Christmas Eve and Christmas Day

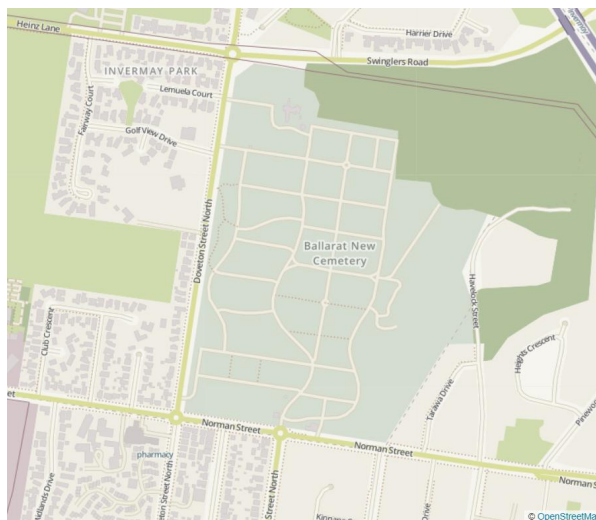

RESPECT FOR ALL

The Ballarat General Cemeteries Trust is committed to maintaining a high standard of presentation of the Ballarat Cemeteries. The following information is supplied so that presentation continues to meet the expectations of the community.

It is natural for people to decorate a grave for sentimental or religious reasons. Ballarat Cemetery acknowledges this and wants to ensure this is done in a safe way that respects the needs of the entire community.

On all lawn grave areas permissible items are only allowed to be placed on the beam beside the plaque or in the garden area.



No items should be placed on the lawn as this creates a risk to the community and cemetery workers when maintaining the area.

SAFETY FIRST

The following pose significant safety risks to the community and cemetery staff. They are prohibited within our cemetery :



To maintain our high standard of presentation, the planting of shrubs other than by cemetery staff is not permitted.

Only vases purchased from and installed by the cemetery are to be used.

MISTAKES CAN HAPPEN

If you inadvertently breach these guidelines we will collect the item/s and store them safely on site.

You will have three (3) months to contact us and arrange to collect the item/s.

After the three month period, uncollected items will be deemed unwanted and will be recycled.
